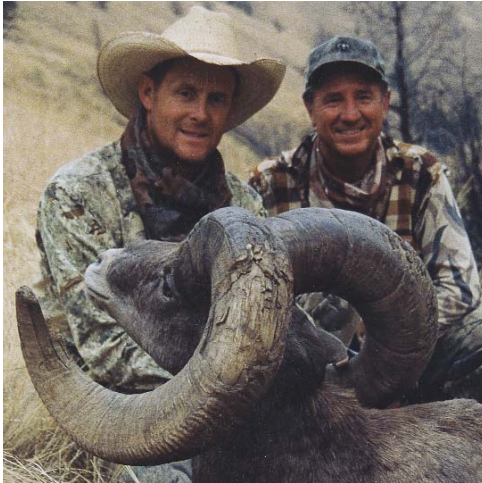


SAFARI TIMES HUNT REPORTS

SCI Life Member Butch Kufлак reports on a hunt with **Craig Martin –Tucannon Outfitters** and guides **Glen Landrus**, and **John Cargill**. Firing a Browning .270 A-Bolt rifle with 150-grain Nosler Partition bullets, Kufлак took his California bighorn sheep at 165 yards. Kufлак was also equipped with Leica 10x42 binocular.

Personal highlights for Kufлак: "The hunt was well coordinated and organized. The country side was just beautiful."

Comments on performance of the guide: "All guides had assignments and each task was accomplished as requested. They were all good company."

Performance of the outfitter: "Extremely well organized. I couldn't have eaten all the food presented if I had stayed a month. I was lacking for nothing. They are absolutely the best."

Hunt date: Mid August to September 2004

Cost of the hunt: \$5,000

UTAH

SCI National Member Donald Perrien reports on a mountain lion hunt in the Pavant unit with guides **Kalan Lemon** and **Wade Lemon** of outfitter **Wade Lemon Hunting**.

Personal highlights for Perrien: "This was my first mountain lion hunt. I took my trophy with a muzzle-loader after a three hour stalk with dogs, five of which the lion cut badly."

Comments on performance of the guides: "Great. In extreme shape. Kalan had great eyesight and is quite a people person. Loves his work."

Performance of the outfitter: "Wade Lemon is very professional and the best lion outfitter in the lower 48 states. He knows his animals and country as well. Everything was as advertised or better."

Interesting sidelights: "Wade had himself, Kalan, and five other sub guides looking for the 'right' lion track. Snow was very deep, and the use of snow machines was fun."

Recommendation: "Wade is the best lion outfitter around."

Hunt date: December 2003

Cost of hunt: \$3,500

AFRICA SOUTH AFRICA

SCI National Member Paul Atkins reports on a hunt with guide **Conrad Du Plooy** of **Dries Visser Safaris**. Atkins took kudu, warthog, gemsbuck, impala, and zebra during his bow hunt in the Limpopo area.

Personal highlights for Atkins: "Taking six animals with six arrows. Getting a zebra and a huge kudu."

Comments on performance of the guide: "Excellent. He knew what he was doing."

Performance of the outfitter: "I could not have asked for a better place to hunt. This is a well run outfitter. The animals are abundant, and they are trophies. The staff is first rate."

Hunt date: Late June to early July 2003

Cost of hunt: \$6,100

SCI National Member Frank Lamberti reports on a hunt with outfitter **Kaan Karakaya - Shikar Safaris**. Guided by **Asad Aziz Kahn's** expertise, Lamberti took a Blanford urial and Sindh ibex in Karachi, Pakistan.

Personal highlights for Lamberti: "I saw plenty of sheep and ibex. The trip went well with no problems."

Comments on performance of the guide: "He was great!"

Performance of the outfitter: "The camp was as nice as any hotel I have been in. The food was great (lamb and chicken)."

General comments: "I drank at least two gallons of water per day. Easy hunting and lots of walking (desert country)."

How To File A Hunt Report

SCI maintains a file of reports about outfitters, guides and hunting conditions. Members are invited to review them before booking their hunts by the Trophy Records Department at SCI Headquarters (520) 620-1220. This service is free to National, International and Chapter members who are, in turn, asked to contribute to the database by submitting detailed reports of their own hunts. SCI accepts reports of hunts taken by SCI members only. Reports

submitted by non-SCI members will not be accepted. Because of the volume of hunt reports received every month, *Safari Times* is unable to publish every report. However, all reports will be filed in the Trophy Records Department for member review.

Use only the official SCI Hunt Report forms. Report must be original, and must include the SCI member's signature and membership number. (For forms, write Hunt Reports, Safari Club International, 4800 W. Gates Pass Rd., Tucson, AZ. 85745.)

Send a separate report for each hunt. Reports are filed

for future use by other members. Put the hunt date on the form, along with the date that the report is submitted. Fill in all the blanks.

To be considered for use in *Safari Times*, photos must be good quality prints of trophy-class animals. Please do not staple. Use paper clips to attach pertinent hunt data such as your name, outfitter name, species, hunt date, trophy score, etc. on a separate piece of paper. Or use a gummed label to affix to back of photo. Never write directly on a photo. Photos cannot be returned.
